St. Raphael Nursery School

A little bit about us...



St. Raphael Nursery School offers an early-childhood program for children who are 3 and 4 years of age, a popular transitional class for older 4's called 4-Plus, and even a program for toddlers and their caregivers. Our play-based curriculum follows the Archdiocese of Washington Catholic Schools Academic Standards. Play is an extraordinary learning tool that bolsters imagination, facilitates problem-solving, supports motor development, builds vocabulary, and enhances social skills. At SRNS, we focus on the whole child—spiritually, mentally, physically, and socially—to foster a safe environment for exploration, resulting in a positive first-time school experience that puts the child on track to a lifelong love of learning.

■ Faith-based teaching in our warm and nurturing environment

■ One teacher and one aide per class—typical class size and student-teacher ratio:
3's: 14 (7:1 ratio)
4's: 16 (8:1 ratio)
4-Plus: 16 (8:1 ratio)

■ Weekly visits from music/religion teacher and Spanish teacher

■ Child-friendly outdoor playground and large gymnasium

■ Outreach events such as food drives for shelters and visits to neighboring Raphael House senior home

■ Nut-aware policy to provide a safe environment for those with food sensitivities

■ Full-time nurse

■ Opportunity to continue K-8 education at St. Raphael School (must apply for admission)
